TOURNAMENT RULES & CONDITIONS

(This sheet should be retained by the competitor for Reference)

1. The tournament shall be conducted under the rules of the International Tennis Federation and TASA.
2. All matches shall be decided on the basis of the best three sets, except for the Mens Singles and Mens Doubles events which shall be decided on the basis of the best of five sets from and including the Quarter Finals.
3. Play shall commence at 08h30 daily and stop at such times as decided by Referee. No concession whatsoever shall be granted to any player.
4. Players must abide by the ruling of the Referee or his deputy as to the court and venue to be used, and the time a match has to commence. Defaulters shall be scratched.
5. All competitors may be required to assist with court duties. Competitors who do not fulfil their obligations shall be liable to disciplinary measures by the Reference Committee.
6. Competitors must wear acceptable tennis attire. The Referee or his deputy shall be the sole judge. No logo's on t-shirts shall be allowed unless approved by the Reference Committee.
7. Competitors shall abide by the decisions and rulings of the Referee, or in his absence that of the Assistant Referee and/or his Reference Committee.
8. Substitutions shall only be done by and with the permission of the Referee in respect of a doubles combination where one player is not available because of an acceptable reason.
9. The Reference Committee reserves the right to modify the programme in any way it deems fit and impose any disciplinary measure.
10. All players must report at the venue at 08h30 on the opening day of the tournament. Registration of all players will take place at the COMPULSORY PLAYERS METTING to be held at the Seva Samaj Hall, Soma Street, Actonville at 9.00 am on Monday, 1st Jan 1990, where a public draw will also take place.
11. All players must register daily on arrival at the venue. Leave of absence shall be granted only by the Referee or his deputy.
12. New balls may be provided during the course of a match at the discretion of the Referee or his deputy.
13. An entry fee of R8,00 per player per event must accompany the completed entry form.
14. The completed entry form, or a reasonable facsimile thereof, must be submitted to the Secretary of the entrant's Union, who shall forward it with a Consolidated Entry Form directly by express post to the National Secretary within 48 hours after the closing date. No telephonic or late entries will be accepted.
15. The responsibility for securing doubles partners rests with the entrant. /and partner entries will only be considered from units where only one player enters. In such a case the referee cannot guarantee competition in a doubles event.
16. The TASA tie-breaker shall be used.
17. The closing date for the submission of TASA Open entries shall be Saturday, 16 December 1989.
18. Entry fees are not refundable.
19. Entries shall only be entertained if submitted in the manner described above.
20. Any player who submits an entry for the TASA Open and fails to participate for reasons other than injury, must through his/her affiliate, inform TASA of the reasons for his/her absence. This must reach TASA 14 days prior to the Councillors meeting failing which the player will be suspended from National and domestic tennis activities until the submissions are fully discussed at a General Meeting.
