HISTORY

The South African Cricket board was formed in 1977 to control Non Racial Cricket in South Africa.

It has done its work successfully and the following units are affiliated to the Board from throughout South Africa.

1. Border Cricket Board.
2. Boland Cricket Board.
3. Eastern Province Cricket Association.
4. Griqualand West Cricket Union.
5. Komani and District Cricket Union
6. Natal Cricket Board.
7. South Western District Cricket Board.
8. South African Primary schools Sports Association.
9. South African Senior Schools Sports Association.
- 10 Transvaal Cricket Board.
- 11 Western Province Cricket Board.
- 12 Victoria East Cricket Board.
- 13 Karoo Cricket Union.

The South African Cricket Board consists of 13 Provincial Units all of which are completely non Racial in character.

As for season 1984/ 85 the Board will administer seven competitions:

1. The A competition known as the "Howa Bowl" in which Eastern Province Cricket Association - Natal Cricket Board - Transvaal Cricket Board - and Western Province Cricket Board Participate, is played on the home-away system. The expenditure incurred is paid by the units themselves.

2. The 'B' Tournament is a competition known as the "Booley Trophy" and is played by all the Units including the 'A' section units entering 'B' teams in the Tournament. It is played on a zonal basis and the finals are played in February/March of each year. The cost of the Tournament is paid by each Unit for the expense incurred by them.

3. The South African Senior Schools Sports association holds its National School week in December of each year where the provincial schools teams compete. A National Schools eleven is selected from this tournament to compete in the South African Cricket Board Tournament.

4. The South African Primary Schools Sports Association also hold its National Schools Week in December of each year where provincial school teams compete.

5. Benson & Hedges Cup competition is played every year and all the units of the Board take part. It is a Knock Out competition and the finals are played every year during the month of March. This competition has been sponsored for the last two years and has been renewed again.

6. The South African Cricket Board Under 21 Tournament will be held in Durban. It will be a centralised tournament and will be played as from the 7th to the 12th of January 1985. This Tournament is open to all units and the cost will be paid by the Board.

7. The South African Cricket Board Under 16 Tournament will be held in Lenasia, Johannesburg. It will be a centralized tournament and will be played as from the 7th to the 12th of January 1985. All the units of the Board are entitled to take part and the cost will be paid by the Board.

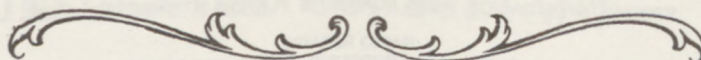
Congratulations and best wishes to the Transvaal Cricket Board for hosting the first Under 16 Tournament under the auspices of the South African Cricket Board.

The Sporting scene has always been and still is a reflection of South African Society which is and contains all the elements of apartheid ideology. Freedom of movement and association which are essential to regular sport, are restricted; amenities and opportunities necessary to gain the highest proficiency are denied to those who do not qualify for citizenship in the land of their birth. Blacks, who despite the lack of facilities and opportunities had the potential or even proved conclusively that they warranted the highest honours, were relegated to obscurity and rejected only because of their colour.

Sports does not exist in isolation, it is a social activity for social beings, and is influenced by the social structure in which it operates. Sports apartheid too, does not exist in isolation, it can only exist in a medium governed by racialist philosophy. If society decrees that its members be forcibly segregated, that facilities and opportunities be restricted on "racial" grounds, as they undoubtedly are in South Africa, then Sport cannot be a regular social activity. Sport then, becomes an arm of political ideology.

The South African Cricket Board accepts as its basic principle the belief in, and commitment to the equality and dignity and worth of all human and envisages a unified South Africa where this principle is respected and entrenched at all levels of society. We believe that only in a society completely free of all racial discrimination is it possible to have "non-racial" sport.

On behalf of the South African Cricket Board we wish all participants a successful tournament.

RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

1. The contingent shall comprise of 14 Players, 1 Manager, 1 Umpire : 16:
2. All selected players shall be registered prior to participating in the tournament.

The computation date to be:-

U 21 : 1 Nov 63 (not over 21 on 31 st October 1984)

U 16 : 1 Nov 68 (not over 16 on 31 st October 1984)

Proof of age to be submitted to scrutinee committee at tournament. Birth certificate or certified copy thereof.

3. HOURS OF PLAY:

Play shall commence punctually at 9:30 a.m. each day, and end at 6:30 / earlier if outright decision has been reached. There shall be a lunch interval of 45 minutes and a tea interval of 15 min. Drinks brakes may be taken midway between each session.

3.1 DURATION OF MATCHES:

9h 30 to 12h 10 (drinks 10h 50)

12h 10 to 12h 55 Lunch

12h 55 to 15h 35 (Drinks 14h 15)

15h 35 to 15h 50 Tea

15h 50 to 18h 30 (Drinks 17h 10)

4. POINTS:

Win by Innings / Default12 points

Win on Double Innings.....10 points

Tie on Double Innings5 points each

Tie on 1 st Innings2 points

Win on 1 st Innings 4 points (Incomplete match)

5. BONUS POINTS:

Batting & Bowling Bonus points shall be scored in the 1 st Innings only, within 55 overs of 6 Balls each, There will be compulsory declaration in the 1 st Innings after the batting side has reached 55 overs.

1 Batting point shall be scored on reaching 100 runs, and 1 point for every 25 runs thereafter. 1 Bowling bonus point shall be scored on every uneven wicket – i.e. 1.3.5.7

6. OVER

The over shall consist of 6 balls.

A new ball shall be used for each match. A second new ball may be used at the commencement of the 2nd Innings.

Teams must maintain an over rate of 16 over to the hour.

A minimum of 20 overs shall be bowled in the last hour of play of each match.

7. TOURNAMENT WINNERS:

a) Shall be the team with the most points.

b) In the case of a tie, by the team with the most outright wins.

c) If there is a tie, then by their team who has scored the most runs per wicket.

8. All participating Units shall pay their own travel costs to the tournament.

S.A.C.B. will provide Accomodation and meals at their cost.

9. The winners of the U21 Tournament will be required to play their Booley play-off

10. All Matches shall be played on a league basis, under the normal I.C.C. rules save the rules set out above.
