



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made and entered into

between EPHRAIM MOLEMA (hereinafter called the

Lessor) of the one part and CHARLES RHODES HULME

(hereinafter called the Lessee) of the other

part WITNESSETH:

That the Lessor with the consent of the

Paramount Chief and Headman of the Barolong Nation,

testified by the signature of the Paramount Chief,

FRANK LOTLAMORENG MONTSIOA to these presents, agrees

to let to the Lessee who agrees to hire certain portion

measuring 10 morgen situate at the Dam on the Western

half of the farm "Lotlaye" measuring about 2950

morgen more or less in the whole situate in the

Bechuanaland Protectorate, of which farm the

Lessor is the legal occupier, on the following

terms and conditions, to wit:-

- 1... The tenancy shall be for a term of five years calculated from the 1st day of February 1923.
- 2... The rent shall be £5 sterling per annum payable in advance to the Lessor at Mafeking.
- 3... The Lessee agrees not to assign or sublet the said farm.
- 4... The Lessee shall be entitled to take dry wood

for.....

for his own use and to cut trees for use on the farm
but shall not be entitled to sell wood or to remove
wood from the farm for any purpose.

shall be taken to occupy the sain farm, and this

Lease shall not be constructed as a disposition or the

said farm.

- 6... The Lessee agrees not to interfere with the natives now living on the said farm.
- enywhere on the said portion measuring 10 morgen.

 8... As further consideration for the said Lease

the Lessee undertakes:-

- (a) To dig a well on the said farm and find sufficient water therein to water 100 herd of cettle per diem
 - (b) To build a house of six rooms of raw brick with pitched iron roof
- (c) To make a dam 100 yards long, the wall of which shall be 7 ft. kigh 14 ft. wide at the bottom and 3 ft. wide at the top.

These improvements the Lessee undertakes to complete before the expiration of this Lesse.

9... The Lessee agrees to occupy the said portion in a proper and husbandlike manner and the Lessor covenants

that so long as the Lessee keeps the conditions hereof,
he shall, subject to the terms and conditions hereof,
here free and undisturbed occupation of the portion during
the said tenancy.

10.. The Lessee shall have the option of renewing this Lease for a further period of five years at a similar rental and subject to similar conditions.

shall hand back the said property with the improvements set out in Section 8 duly completed and in good order and repair but shall not be entitled to any compensation whatsoever in respect of the said improvements or any other improvements effected on the saidfarm.
