St Peters New Leeds.

In fly leaf of register a declaration
22nd Nov 1874 by W.H. Fenton to the effect
that sometime about Jan. 1868 the Rev.

F.S. Robinson, when by a judgment of the
Supreme Court the faithful were deprived

of the use of many of the Churches,
did deposit with him a chalice & paten
of silver contained in an oaken box, asking
him to keep it for use in the church
at New Leeds. He is about to leave the
Colony & so as St Peter's is now held by the
Board of Trustees under the trust created by
the Provincial Synod, he executes his trust.
