Memorandum of Agreement

Made and entered this day of May 1898

Between Silas J. Protema and J. J. Van Rooyen

That in consideration of the said Van Rooyen ploughing a piece of ground known as Jantougan for a period of one year and that afore said J. J. Van Rooyen give to the aforesaid Silas J. Protema half of all produce in consideration of the afore said Silas J. Protema supplying seed or oxen and that the afore said J. J. Van Rooyen agree to plant and cultivate in a proper and husband like manner all fruit trees in the afore said piece of ground

That the aforesaid Silas J. Protema promises to the said Van Rooyen that if he carries on the terms and conditions thereof of the said J. J. Protema will allow the ^{said} J. J. Van Rooyen more years

That the said Van Rooyen shall not at any time assign or sublet the said property without the consent in writing of the Lessor
