
May I please trouble you just once more?

- 1) Referring to your letter of May 4, is it possible to list the subjects studied by Mr Sobukwe on a year by year basis?
- 2) Your letter refers to annual "tuition fees" of £55. Would the hostel fees thus have been a separate item? If so, is there any information about their extent and who paid them?
- 3) The statistics of student enrolment for Fort Hare which I have, and which are culled from the Government Year Book, relate to 1946 and reflect an enrolment of 324: 260 were blacks, 29 Indians and 35 coloureds. Of the 324, 31 were women, 14 students came from Basutoland, and 18 from elsewhere in Africa.

Are comparable statistics perhaps available for 1947 and 1949?

Again, I hope you will not mind my addressing these inquiries to you.
