Having heard Mr. J. COAKER of Counsel for the Applicants and Mr. H.J. LIEBENBERG of Counsel for the Respondent and having read the Petition and other documents filed of record:-

IT IS ORDERED:

1. THAT the Applicants be and are hereby released on bail in the amount of:-
  - £250. each for Europeans
  - £100. each for Indians and Asiatics
  - £50. each for Africans and coloured persons.
2. THAT the bail, be and is hereby extended on the same terms and conditions as before, as granted by the Honourable Mr. Justice Dowling, until the conclusion of the trial, or a variation of the terms by a competent Court.

CONDITIONS OF RECOGNIZANCE.

The amount of bail in respect of the Europeans is £250, £100 in the case of Indians and in the case of Africans and Coloured persons £50.

The accused persons shall not attend any gathering other than a gathering of a social nature or religious nature or a gathering of an educational at a recognised educational institution or a gathering which is of a sporting or recreational nature but that no accused person shall address any gathering of any kind.

In connection with one of the accused persons who is a member of parliament this order does not purport to restrict in any way his right to attend and address gatherings of parliament.

The amount of bail is to be furnished either in cash or by a surety or two sureties approved by the Magistrate of Johannesburg.

Each accused person to report weekly on every Thursday before 10 a.m. to a police station within the Union of South Africa to be nominated by each individual accused person and be stated in the bail bond or the bail receipt.

Each accused person is to surrender any passport or any permit to leave the Union of South Africa. No accused person must communicate in any way with any Crown witness.

As regards the accused person the Reverend Thompson I make an exception in his case so as to permit him to conduct normal religious services at his Church in Springs and the condition is imposed that he shall furnish the police in advance a copy of any sermon which he intends to deliver.

These/.....

These accused persons who are legal practitioners are not to be restricted from their practice in the ordinary course if the practice involves addressing gatherings before Courts of Law and tribunals.

Any accused person has the right to apply for a variation.

I nominate the police station of \_\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of reporting as per these conditions.

These conditions have been read out to me. We fully appreciate and understand same.

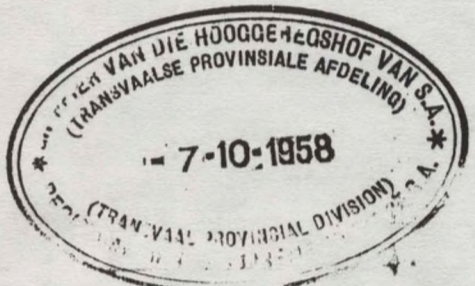

Dear Sir,

We are pleased to be able to advise you that the Defamation Actions instituted against Voortrekkerpers Beperk, Dagbreekpers Beperk and M. D. C. De Wet Nel have now all been settled.

In terms of the settlements Voortrekkerpers Beperk have paid an amount of £625, Dagbreekpers Beperk a sum of £2,000 and M. D. C. De Wet Nel the sum of £780, making a total of £3,405 in all. After deducting fees and costs there is an amount of £200 available for distribution to each of the Plaintiffs and we have pleasure in enclosing herewith a cheque for that amount in your favour.

In addition an amount of £39 was paid in to us by Mr. E. Brown as a contribution towards the initial costs of these Actions and this amount is being refunded to Mr. Brown so that those persons who contributed towards the £39 may obtain a refund of their contribution from Mr. Brown.

The costs in all the matters amounted to the sum of £805. We may say that this includes a sum of £26. 5. 0. which has been retained by us in order to purchase Advocate Pollack a gift for his work in providing us with an opinion at an early stage in the proceedings. We presume that you are agreeable to this but should you not be, kindly advise us as early as possible.

A full statement will be provided early in the New Year.
