Be it hereby made known:

That I Alfred Bet of 26

Park Lane London recognising the paramount necessity of Education in all its branches, whether general, special, technical, agricultural or otherwise; being desirous of assisting in its promotion especially in the Transvaal; and deeming the Estate of Frankenwald formerly in extent Four hundred and seventy one morgen five hundred and twenty six roods but now increased by the acquisition of certain adjoining land to Seven hundred and seventy one morgen five hundred and twenty six roods, situated on the Farm Klipfontein N° 88, district Pretoria a suitable and convenient site for the erection of educational premises and the carrying on of educational establishments of various kinds Do hereby give and grant to and on behalf of Raymond William Schumacher

and Frederic John Carpenter acting
on my behalf and Adam Jameson
in his capacity as the present
Commissioner of Lands and Fabian
Ware in his capacity as the present
Director of Education acting on behalf
of the Government of the Transvaal
and their successors in office as
Trustees of this Gift; my ^{said} Estate of
Frankenwald now being and consisting
of two portions of the farm Klipfontein
N^o. 88 situate in the district of
Pretoria, Transvaal, and in extent
Four hundred and seventy one morgen
five hundred and twenty six roods
and three hundred morgen respectively
in freehold ownership, absolutely and
forever, to be by them held in trust
to the intent that the same shall be
used in perpetuity by the Government
of the said Colony of the Transvaal
for Educational purposes of all kinds
and solely and only for such purposes
provided always that the Government
may with the consent of the said
Trustees and their successors lease
portion of the said Estate not

required to give effect to such purposes as aforesaid; and provided further that the rents received from any such lease shall be applied to the aforesaid purposes.

I further declare that upon the due creation and constitution of a Government Department, Board or Commission University or Body duly charged by Government with the carrying on of educational objects upon the said land, the said Trustees and their successors shall be and they are hereby irrevocably authorised and empowered to effect and pass a formal transfer of the said land to such Government Department, Board, Commission, University or Body for use by it on the conditions and for the objects herein set forth.

I further declare that notwithstanding that a formal deed of transfer according to the laws of the Transvaal is about to be passed of this said land to the said Trustees, I am willing to continue the care management and cultivation

use and occupation of the said
Frankenwald in such manner as
I shall myself think fit, at my
own proper charge, conditionally
upon my receiving the fruits,
profits and returns arising there-
from for my own use until such
time as it is convenient to the
Government of the Transvaal to
assume such duties, whereupon the
said care, management, cultivation
use and occupation shall be taken
over by my said Trustees or their
successors for the purposes aforesaid
at the sole charge and expense of
the Government of the Transvaal
Provided always that upon my
decease, my Estate shall be at once
freed from such duties which shall
thereupon and forthwith devolve on
my said Trustees at the sole
expense of the said Government.
Whereas it was a condition of
the foregoing gift that the Government
of the Transvaal should increase
the area of the ground by itself
acquiring such conveniently situated

ground as could be purchased in
the vicinity with the object of
incorporating the former with the
latter and of devoting the whole
to the purposes afores recited, and
the Government has accordingly
acquired a portion of the farm
Bergvlei N^o. 199, district Pretoria
in extent four hundred and seventy
two morgen two hundred and eighty
square rods adjoining my property of
Frankenwald above mentioned.

It is a distinct condition of this
gift that the Government shall
devote the said portion of Bergvlei
solely and only in conjunction with
the land forming the subject of
this gift and only for the purposes
of such gift.

I reserve to myself and the
said Raymond William Schumacher
and Frederic John Carpenter and
also failing us to my executors
and administrators the right to
appoint successors from time to time
to the said Raymond William
Schumacher and Frederick John

Carpenter as Trustees such right
of appointment becoming after my
death vested first in the Trustees
for the time being and failing
any appointment by them then in
my executors and administrators am
I reserve and grant to the Governm^t
of the Transvaal the right to
appoint from time to time success-
to the said Adam Jameson and
Fabian Ware until such time as
transfer shall be passed to the
Department, Board, Commission,
University or other Body afore-
mentioned

Saint Michael and Saint George
Governor of the Orange River Colony

and of the Transvaal and His
Majesty's High Commissioner for South
Africa hereby accept the said gift
on behalf of the Government of the
Transvaal and the present and future
inhabitants thereof upon the conditions
named and We the said Raymond
William Schumacher and Frederic
John Carpenter and Adam Jameson
and Fabian Ware accept the Trust
hereinbefore set out and promise to
see to and insure the carrying out
of the same to the best of our
ability.
