21st J. of P. Thomas. Mr. Wilkins said Mass. Mary Evans went off to Heelbron & her situation at 7.a.m.

22nd Mr. Wilkins came & heard all the girls' Confession in the afternoon. Clara came down & made hers & Rhona also. Girl went on working till 4thp.

23rd IV Sunday in Advent. S.N. S.G. & S.A. went to 7thp Mass S.S. m. to 8thp. S.N. & S.S. A. took girls to Melius' & Oldwater Service. Clara came down in the afternoon.

24th Christmas Eve S.G. very busy making creche.

W. Carter called. Planted her cart & mules for S.H. to drive up to the School. S.H. just went to see Superior. Nurse came out from Hospital. Came to borrow some money. Vespers 5.30 Evensong 6.30. All communicants had a little Retreat till 8.30. Then went to bed. S. A. C. & S. Alice came down in ^{Maryann} the afternoon to take ^{the} child away & Johnnay by the morning with some presents.

25: Christmas Day. S.H. S.S.H. & S.C. took all communicants & 60% mass. S.G. went to 7 o'clock. Short service in Chapel before girls breakfast. Girls only had cards & sweets on breakfast table. S.G. & S.S.H. took girls to Malins. S.S.H. went on to see them at the school. Had lunch when they came home. Then girls all went to rest. Sisters also. 3 p.m. S.H. S.G. & S.A. drove up to the School & then went on with all the girls to have tea with the Bishops Mr. Carter. Sir George Laidle ^{let} ~~drive~~ all three ^{drive} back

in his cart. Vespers. 5.30. Evening. 6 p.m.
Dinner 6.30. all the girls & sisters & ladies
together. After dinner presents were given
away. Then they had a little concert-
ended up with two carols.

31st S.L. came in the afternoon. Dr. H. called to see Violet. S.H. went up to the school to Choral Vespers & Procession at 6.45. Staged on to supper & to see Superior.

Jan 1st 1907. of the Circumcision Recto's came down to say mass at 6 o'clock. All Catechists present. Girls worked till 5.30. Mr. Wilkins came to say Rensselaer & give address. Sisters' Confessions. Ellen received in. Katherine dismissed ^{Evening} girls entertained sisters.

2nd Mr. Body said Mass. Miss Col came down. Miss Tompkins went out for the day. S.H. left

hosp. T. she was not suitable.

3rd S.H. went up to see the Bishops. S.H. & S.M. took all the girls matron^{s. 30} to tea at the School. Madeleine, Mr. Ann. left blind - sang Eumenong at the School.

4th Mrs. Colleens said mass. 'hurri' called. Mr. Collies called in the afternoon. Mr. Peasey called.

5th Matron had middle day, had to put bed. Mr. Middleton (auditor) called. Mr. Carlos called.

6th of the Epiphany. S.G. S.S. & S.H. went to 7 o'clock mass with girls. S.H. went to 8 o'clock. S.G. took girls to Melvin. Matron in bed all day. Kalkarwe & Clara came down to tea. No one went to Eumenong.

7th Matron still bad. S.G. was to have gone to the school but S.H. wrote to Sup't to say the cloud spare her till Matron was better. S. Emily Currie came down to help. Margaret Hedges decided to go but at the last moment changed her mind & promised to stop. Her name changed to 'Madeleine'.
