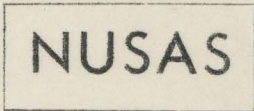

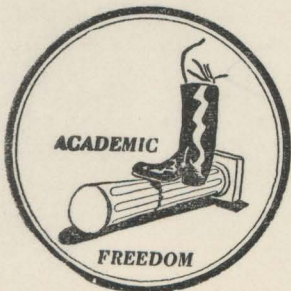
The airfare is being paid from CADET money and not by private persons, so please do let us know what is owed to you.
