

Memorandum of agreement of lease made and entered into at Mafeking,
 Bechuanaland, Cape Province, on this the day of -
 Between - of Mafeking aforesaid, hereinafter styled the lessor,
 of the one part,

And - also of - aforesaid, hereinafter styled the lessee, of the other part.

The lessor hereby lets to the lessee, who hereby hires from certain portions
 of the Farm School situated in the Bechuanaland Protectorate, measuring
 one morgen, more or less, which said husband has pointed out by the said
 lessor to the said lessee.

The period of this lease shall be seven years, reckoned from the day of -

on the condition that the said lessee shall dig two or three wells, and Dams
 on the Farm, two or three years without paying the Rent on the said
 Farm, four or five years to pay the Rent of Twelve pounds per annum.

The said lessee hereby binds himself to dig the wells and make a Dam.

The lessee shall not assign or sublet the property hereby leased without
 the consent in writing of the lessor first being had and obtained.

The lessee shall not fell or cut, or cause to be felled or cut, any trees
 growing on the property hereby leased
 without the consent of the lessor first being had and obtained.

The lessee, however, shall be allowed to fell or cut such timber or trees as may be
 absolutely necessary for domestic or other purposes, without the consent of
 the lessor first being had and obtained.
