REPRESENTATIVES TO PROVINCIAL SYNOD 1909.



The Certificates required under Section 8 Canon I are all in order. The following Dioceses have however failed to return the full number of Lay Representatives that they are entitled to,

1. The Diocese of St. Johns is entitled to six Lay Representatives, but only three have been returned.
2. The Diocese of Bloemfontein is entitled to seven, but only six have been returned.
3. The Diocese of Zululand is entitled to three, but only two have been returned.

2. The Diocese of Lebombo.
