Re: The report that Aron Mbambi
was in conjunction with the Native Affairs
Department engaged a case against
us. It appears that Mbambi according
to his papers has been in the employ of the
Union without being registered and therefore
the matter has been taken up by the C.I.D.
I understand they want to take up Criminal
proceedure. While at the same time he claims
£6-0-0 for 3 months arrears, October and
November. I offered him £4 in front of the
Clerk of the Court - which he refused maintaining
that he was a bona fide employee of the
Union and could not be discharged by us.

So. I left the matter in the hands of
the board. They intimated to me that the
State matter would be dealt with in the
Summer and was going to be revised.
I am waiting for some.

I have also opened the Branch
at P. M. Burg. On Sunday I was
there and enrolled 25 members
including Mr J. S. Linnick. All the
members (official) of the Congress at P. M. Burg
supported me.
