May 4 <sup>th</sup>	Saturday	<p>Vespers was said directly after Dinner.</p> <p>Extra chairs were put into Chapel so that there were four rows on the South Side &amp; 3 rows at the back. Benches were borrowed from the Government School &amp; placed on the North Side. The girls sat on them. The two long desks from the back were put in the Sanctuary for the Clergy. The chair from S. in charge's room &amp; the Priest's desk were put on the top Sanctuary steps for the Bishop with a chair beside it for his Chaplain. On the North Side a similar chair was placed for the Sisters' Chaplain. The Bishop's Clergy &amp; Sisters assembled in the hall. The Bishop &amp; his Chaplain went round to the West Door from the outside. The Sisters &amp; Clergy went in Procession through the cloister to the West Door which was shut. The Bishop knocked at the door which was then thrown open.</p>

J<sup>r</sup>. Hart acted as Sisters' chaplain, as the  
Dean was absent from home. He read  
a Petition, signed by himself & the Sisters,  
asking the Bishops to Dedicate the Chapel.  
The Bishop then said "I am ready to proceed  
to the Dedication" & attended by his Chaplain,  
W<sup>r</sup>. Gibbons entered the Chapel & went up  
to the Sanctuary followed by the Clergy, the  
Sisters entering their stalls. The Clergy  
present were J<sup>r</sup>. Hart, W<sup>r</sup>. Gibbons, W<sup>r</sup>. Stey, W<sup>r</sup>. M<sup>r</sup>.  
W<sup>r</sup>. Marshall, W<sup>r</sup>. Allen & W<sup>r</sup>. Carlisle. W<sup>r</sup>. Carlisle  
was thurifer & W<sup>r</sup>. Hancock carried the Cross.  
The hymn 395 was sung while the Clergy &  
Sisters took their places. A lesson was then  
read by J<sup>r</sup>. Hart. Then the hymn 242 was  
sung, the congregation kneeling, while the  
dedication of the various places took place -  
a Verse being sung after each prayer -  
e. g. The Verse "we love Thine Altar Lord" being sung

after the Dedication of the Altar. Then the Bishops read & Sealed the Licence Setting the Chapel apart from all profane use, after which he solemnly dedicated the whole building. Hymn 215 was sung while the alms were collected. The Collectors were Mr. Fearnley, Mr. Wilson, churchwardens at the Cathedral & Mr. Leslie treasurer to the House of Mercy Committee. Then the Bishops gave an address and gave the Blessing. Hymn 379 was sung as the Clergy processed out of Chapel. \* Fr. Hart & Fr. Alston were both at Evensong. Fr. Alston acting as Thurifer. Fr. Hart gave a short sermon.

Sunday in the Octave of the Dedication. Fr. Alston preached at Matins.
