(This sheet should be retained by the competitor for Reference)

1. The tournament shall be conducted under the rules of the International Tennis Federation and TASA.
2. All matches shall be decided on the basis of the best three sets.
3. Play shall commence at 09h00 daily and stop at such times as decided by the Referee. No concession whatsoever shall be granted to any player.
4. Players must abide by the ruling of the Referee or his deputy as to the court and venue to be used, and the time a match has to commence. Defaulters shall be scratched.
5. All competitors may be required to assist with court duties. Competitors who do not fulfil their obligations shall be liable to disciplinary measures by the Reference Committee.
6. Competitors must wear acceptable tennis attire. The Referee or his deputy shall be the sole judge. No logo's on t-shirts shall be allowed unless approved by the Reference Committee.
7. Competitors shall abide by the decisions and rulings of the Referee, or in his absence that of the Assistant Referee and/or his Reference Committee.
8. Substitutions shall only be done by and with the permission of the Referee in respect of a doubles combination where one player is not available because of an acceptable reason.
9. The Reference Committee reserves the right to modify the programme in any way it deems fit and impose any disciplinary measure.
10. All players must report at the venue at 09h00 on the opening day of the tournament.
11. All players must register daily on arrival at the venue. Leave of absence shall be granted only by the Referee or his deputy.
12. New balls may be provided during the course of a match at the discretion of the Referee or his deputy.
13. An entry fee of R7.00 for singles & R5.00 for doubles per player per event must accompany the completed entry form.
14. The completed entry form, or a reasonable facsimile thereof, must be submitted on the Secretary of the entrant's Union who shall forward it with a Consolidated Entry Form directly to the address given on or before the closing date.
15. The TASA tie-breaker shall be used in all sets except final set, lead by 2 games.
16. The closing date for submitting entries shall be Sunday 25th September 1988.
17. Entry fees are not refundable.
18. Entries shall only be entertained if submitted in the manner described above.
