"ATLANTIC CHARTER" COMMITTEE,

1. TERMS OF REFERENCE:

- (a) To examine and report various suggested schemes for post-war reconstruction in Africa with special reference to Southern Africa.
- (b) In the light of the foregoing to formulate a statement of principles and a programme of action with a view of ensuring that African needs and aspirations in regard to different aspects of African individual and social life receive adequate attention in the post-war development of South Africa.

2. MEMBERSHIP:

In terms of the resolution passed at the Annual Conference of the African National Congress, the President-General has invited the following Africans to serve on the "Atlantic Charter" Committee:- (see attached list)

3. PROCEDURE:

- (a) In order to facilitate the work of the Committee the President has divided the General Committee into the following sub-Committees, each one of which will be entrusted with the task of preparing preliminary draft proposals in regard to the subject coming within their purview.
- (b) The draft proposals of each Sub-Committee shall be submitted to the General Committee for consent and approval.
- (c) Finally, a comprehensive statement will be drawn up by the Committee embodying the recommendations of the different Sub-Committee and the African's demands for full citizenship rights in the land of his forefathers.
- (d) Calling of a Convention to ratify the statement of recommendations and demands as set out in the Committee's report, and, signing of the ratified report by members of the Committee.
- (e) Publication of the document and its presentation to the Union Government and the United Nations as the just, fair, and considered, claims of the African people.
