PROTOCOL No. _____

Antenuptial Contract.

Be it hereby made known:

That on this the 25th day of MARCH, in the year of Our Lord, One Thousand Nine Hundred and FORTY-ONE (1941)

before me HAROLD EPHRAIM BRAUDE

of JOHANNESBURG Notary Public,
by lawful authority, duly sworn and admitted, and in the presence of the subscribed witnesses, personally came and appeared

LIONEL BERNSTEIN
Bachelor (Born on the 5th day of March, 1920)

and

HILDA LILIAN SCHWARTZ
Spinster (Born on the 15th day of April, 1915)

Both of Johannesburg, and both being of full and competent age.

And these Appearers did declare, that whereas a marriage hath been agreed upon, and is intended to be forthwith had and solemnized between the said LIONEL BERNSTEIN and the said

HILDA LILIAN SCHWARTZ

they have contracted and agreed, as by these Presents they do contract and agree, each with the other, as follows, to wit :—

FIRST.—That there shall be no community of Property between the said intended Consorts, but that he or she shall respectively retain and possess all his or her estate and effects, movable and immovable, in possession, expectancy or contingency, or to which he or she has or may have any eventual right or title, as fully and effectually as he or she might or could have if the said intended marriage did not take place.

SECOND.—That the one of them shall not be answerable for the debts and engagements of the other of them ; but that each shall be answerable for his or her own debts, contracted before and after the said intended marriage.

THIRD.—That all inheritances, legacies, gifts, or bequests, which may devolve upon, or be left, given, or bequeathed to either of the said intended Consorts, shall be the sole and exclusive property of him or her upon or to whom the same shall devolve or be left, given, or bequeathed.

FOURTH.—That each of the said intended Consorts shall be at full liberty to dispose of his or her property and effects, by will, codicil or other testamentary disposition, as he or she may think fit.

FIFTH.—That there shall be no community of profit and loss between the said Consorts, but that each of them shall respectively retain the profits made by or accruing to him or her, and shall in like manner separately and solely bear and sustain the losses happening to him or her during the subsistence of the said intended marriage.

SIXTH.—That the said HILDA LILIAN SCHWARTZ

shall have and continue to hold, possess, and enjoy the sole exclusive and uncontrolled administration and alienation of all the property and effects which she is now possessed of, and entitled to, and of all other property which she may hereafter acquire during the subsistence of the said marriage without the interference, control or assistance of the said

LIONEL BERNSTEIN

and every marital power which the said

LIONEL BERNSTEIN

shall, or may have, or be entitled to acquire by virtue of the said marriage, shall be and the same is hereby excluded from all the property, estate and effects of the said

HILDA LILIAN SCHWARTZ

as fully and absolutely as if the said intended marriage had not taken place.

SEVENTH:— THAT for and in consideration of the said intended marriage, the said LIONEL BERNSTEIN undertakes to give to the said HILDA LILIAN SCHWARTZ Furniture and household effects to the value of ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY POUNDS (£150. 0. 0.) and allows her to retain as her sole property any wedding gifts and moneys that may be given to them jointly on the occasion of their marriage.

EIGHTH: — THAT in the event of the said HILDA LILIAN SCHWARTZ predeceasing the said LIONEL BERNSTEIN each and all of the said donations, or such part as shall not have been consumed during the subsistence of the said intended marriage, shall revert back and again become the absolute property of the said LIONEL BERNSTEIN

UPON WHICH CONDITIONS the said intended Consorts respectively promise and agree to solemnise their contemplated marriage and respectively to act up to the tenor of these presents under obligation of their persons and property according to Law.

THUS DONE, CONTRACTED AND AGREED UPON at JOHANNESBURG, on the day, month and year first aforewritten, in the presence of the subscribing witnesses.
