These are notes made in 1960 just before
 being arrested. Can't decipher them all,
 but they reveal the amount of running around
 looking for places to hide, to meet, to sleep,
 to keep the organisation functioning.

SH 4 April. Shelly - the rice hard pillows - Cor mattress in twisted shape. (2)
feeling left by frog down a few mountains of water flavoured with cream with cold
Kroger's around the banks of dry bread & newly cold, sweetish brown water that is called
coffee. All heavy eyes & head aching, told to line up for the doctor. (After breakfast - huge tin
dish filled with white pop. Omelette on dried milk - brown bread butter.) AM. Feels dumpy & rebellious
decided to make fun about everything on these lines: 'Beats - can't sleep, we want pillows, sheets,
knaps of chopped nuts, cranial are disgusting - unhygienic. Food is all carbohydrates - we will all be ill
many of us are middle-aged women who can't adjust so easily to such a diet.'

Nation a bit upset # we didn't take care of complaints to law. Dr. was balding, he specialised
with lots of men who either suffered from a nagging wife or indigestion (or both) & didn't find
life funny at all. Asked me to prepare memo # he would pass on. On first victory!

Then we are told Colonel is coming, we may appoint Deputations to bring our complaints before
Colonel. Mr (as food expert), Sulamith (as lawyer), Betty & Me (as outspoken political) draw up the
Colonel, started by telling us we were delayers, but must conform to certain regulations. He will
be satisfied if that regulation were addressed to - then take down our names.

Specimen also arrives: Was 20 bush a bit of our food in. Swims of transfer materials
with shattering effect. What a day! After this, girls see rebel plate on table, think
of a kiss - decide to investigate. Shelia climbs on Ned's shoulder, on bed, with great effort reach
& pull at plate - down came cloud of black dust - blumous laughter.
Supper was great bunch of cold potatoes & lumps of sodid, salty meat - see could't
let it



SUN 10 - Woke after dreadful dream of Kandi, Bay 11, Christmas left alone, to freezing
morning - we were all shivering. That shelly uncoated messy stuff for
breakfast & warm sweet water. Headache again. Opened whole morning discussing,
drafting & re - writing memo on food to Dr. about 11 - 12 parcels of clothes. (3)

Supper tonight was slightly but definitely better - smaller portions, warmer, & a
little less horrible, we ate well - apart from meat, we ate rice & coffee & bread &
jam, we had apples, tomatoes, cheese, biscuits, I wrote a letter Dave tonight, whether it
will ever reach its destination or not I do not know.
Lorraine tells us: As she was leaving her home with the cops after arrest, she suddenly
put her hands to her ears & said "Oh God, I've forgotten my car keys!" One cop gave her
such a judging look. "Madam, I don't think you'll need them, this is France."
Another busy day nearly gone - I haven't had time to read a word or do a sketch of

THURSDAY 14 APRIL A quiet morning. We can't continue with shorthand because of lack of materials
we set in + sun again seeing & kindly discussion with V on yesterday's case which eventually became a
bit heated & acrimonious because of Ed & Tony's mixed fall. It was felt it was best to split & reflect.

I know of no reason why I have been detained & I cannot make any rep. other than a formal request
for my immediate release.

FRI. 15 APRIL Good Friday, Holy Day & my birthday. A chill wind & cold day. The girls sang "Happy
Birthday" at 6 this morning. For + second morning running - no coffee. Our weekly
breakfast - soap from Sarah, chocolate from Molly, an Easter Egg from Rica, Smarties from Trudy. They are
all sweeties, & wonderful. Thinking how Salim was torn between coming with us & the other at
Bethlehem & being a + COP girl - has nice to have my difficulties addressed for you. All the COP
people here don't have to spend each weekend in confinement.
Too cold to sit outside this morning. Dan's wine very busy with our a/c. Rica & King play chess.
In response to our requests for raw veg. Such as potatoes, carrots & cabbage, a basket of raw potatoes & one of
raw cauliflower arrived this morning. As the food is cooked in + man's side, no cooking facilities here
hence came early because of holiday. While lunching - some arrives! Announced these: Great welcome
but we are all bitterly sorry she had been asked to. We accepted all our beds up, declared we can
make room for her. Such a lot to hear & to tell, lovely to see her - much nicer if she had's come.
We have been locked up a long time today - Holyday. Only a short time out
+ Helle has received a "high protein diet". Helle best to prevent skin complaint. She is
comparing cardiac failure - one of 3 categories for alcohol. Such a diet can be prescribed. She is

& not miss as, but he will forget us too. We shall have to re-established a relationship, & how long
will it be?

We have been warned again not to speak to the E. women. They are doing well if we're smart. We have been told they are keeping the 2.1 women here as long as we are detained - to some use. Some didn't connect the women with h.1, & was most surprised. Some wanted to know to see Mrs. B. Tony's Evelyn came. It was a nice visit together, I like & shared. Tony did not look so bright. There was not so much to say. Keith came mentioned us. Frances did not go to piano lessons. I am near, called Madeline Rose. Tony had a big ring on his birthday present to her. She is going to a party on Sat but her birthday. I was depressed. It suddenly seems a long time to leave them, with not the faintest idea of how much longer it will be. I came in & wrote to the P, & did a page of drawings for Keith. Dreamed about the magazine, all again & confusion.

THURS. 28. Brother duty today - not my favorite chore. Fine, but still intelligent cloud & rain apart all morning preparing my talk on Alan Watts. Had letter from Pat & Frances - both so typical. Frances says I miss you & wish you were home. So do I! But lots of parcel arrived for lots of people - & one for me, with "hot" vest, Jersey, knitted wool. After this I felt on top of world once more, & so happy as could be. Hardly been outside today, what with lectures & duties. But on a whole a pleasant day. My lecture went on so long, it has to be continued tomorrow. Lots of news is getting in down, & food is a bit of a trial, but more books raw (some came with my clothes) & more to do. As a result of Blair's visit they have turned 3 of our bedrooms out of + 3 into a really room. We have been given an extra table, but both table round there & 3 round all round. This is room for most of us - not all - to sit around + table & eat in comfortable decency. They all looked amazing, for 21 not young ladies eat together like school children seemed odd.
