stacles that every teacher encounters in the course of his work. Such teachers think it wonld be an admirable thing if school children cuald materialise without parents. Now an obstacle is at least something that must be taken account of, and such pirents are in much better case than those who, as far as the tzacher is concerned simply do not exist at all.

There are too many teachers of both types in our schools, and we should not find it neceasary to point out that both are utterly and inexcusably wrong. No school can fulfil its purpose in the social structure nnless there
exist a right relation betwern exist a right relation between
the teacher and the parent. What then is the relationship that shonld exist between these two parties 10 whom the nature, guardianship and education of the young belong?

There must be tact and and friendliness in all their enntacts. Ha is a bad teacher wholeads his pupils to think that their parents are illiterate or ignorant or careless or
is any way incapable of in any way incapable of rightly. They are unworthy parents who discuss a teach. er's failings in the presence oi dosnything that tends to destroy that unquestioning confidence that every pupil must have in his teachers. There must be cu-operation bet ween teacher and parent.
Both have begun to store up experience in the habits and

characteristics and aptitudes of children, and each has something-however little has m y be-to contribute for the guidance of the other. The school must lie near to the heart of both parent and teacher, both of whom again must never for one moment lose hold of their belief in the educability and inherent goodness of all schnol children. We fan the two get t gether? We firmly believe, not only that they can, but also that they must.
