Clause 1.Name.

The name of the club shall be the " Azad
Cricket Club ".

Clause 2.Colours.

The colours of the club shall be Maroon
and White.

Clause 3.Fees.

The fees of each affiliated member shall be
R2.10 joining fees and R4.50 season fees.

Clause 4.

The Annual General Meeting, of the club
shall be held not later than September.

Clause 5(A)Office Bearers.

The officers, of the club shall consist of
3 patrons. 1 Chairman, 1 Vice Chairman,
2 Secretaries, 1 Treasurer and 1 Auditor.

Clause 5(B)Committee.

The following shall be the standing committee
which shall be elected at the A.G.M.

- (a) Executive Committee.
- (b) Selection Committee.
- (c) Members shall be elected to the
committees together with the
officials.

Clause 6.

Quorum.

The Quorum for the A.G.M. and general meetings shall be one third of the members.

Clause 7.

Discharge Fees.

Members wishing to leave the club will be issued with a clearance certificate on payment of R2.10 and all outstanding fees and fines.

Clause 8.

Banking Account.

The Chairman, Secretary and the Treasurer shall open a banking/or Saving Account, in the name of the club and they shall jointly be the signatories for the operation of such an account.

Clause 9.

Affiliation.

All players seeking affiliation to the club must do so in writing before A.G.M.

Clause 10.

Penalty.

Any players or members who has been penalised by the club shall have the right to apeal to the executive committee.

Clause 11.

Attendance.

Should any members of the club be absent for three consecutive meetings, without a logical explanation they shall be dealt by the committee.

Clause 12.

The object of the club are to forster, promote and encourage the game of cricket.

Clause 6.

Quorum.

The Quorum for the A.G.M. and general meetings shall be one third of the membership.

Discharge Fees.
