#### **TOURNAMENT RULES & CONDITIONS**

(This sheet should be retained by the competitor for Reference)

1. The tournament shall be conducted under the rules of the international Tennis Federation.
2. All matches shall be decided on the basis of the best three sets, except for the Men's Singles and Men's Doubles events which shall be decided on the basis of the best of five sets from and including the Quarter Finals.
3. Play shall commence at 09h00 daily and stop at such times as decided by the Referee.
4. Players must abide by the ruling of the Referee or his deputy as to the court and venue to be used, and the time a match has to commence. Defaulters shall be scratched.
5. All competitors may be required to assist with court duties. Competitors who do not fulfil their obligations shall be liable to disciplinary measures by the Reference Committee.
6. Competitors must wear acceptable tennis attire. The Referee or his deputy shall be the sole judge.
7. Competitors shall abide by the decisions and rulings of the Referee, or in his absence that of the Assistant Referee and/or his Reference Committee.
8. Substitutions shall only be done by and with the permission of the Referee in respect of a doubles combination where one player is not available because of an acceptable reason.
9. The Reference Committee reserves the right to modify the programme in any way it deems fit and impose and disciplinary measure.
10. All players must report at the venue at 09h00 on the opening day of the tournament.
11. All players must register daily on arrival at the venue. Leave of absence shall be granted only by the Referee or his deputy.
12. New balls may be provided during the course of a match at the discretion of the Referee or his deputy.
14. An entry fee of R5.00 per player per event must accompany the completed entry form.
15. The completed entry form, or a reasonable facsimile thereof, must be submitted to the Secretary of the entrant's Union who shall forward it directly by EXPRESS POST to the address given within 48 hours after the closing date.
16. Entry fees shall be paid directly to the National Treasurer on or before the opening day of the tournament by an official or representative of each affiliate.
17. The closing date for submitting entries shall be 8 DECEMBER
18. Entry fees are not refundable
19. Entries shall only be entertained if submitted in the manner described above.
20. The TASA tie-breaker shall be used.
21. All entrants will be obliged to attend the BGM on Sunday January 2nd 1983.
