

(C) Then we shall go into action.

There is enough awareness and good will among the Africans, to start.

A. Congress should therefore forthwith launch a serious appeal for a "Liberation Fund" to which every African adult shall contribute no less than Ten-shillings ~~etc.~~ and those who can, to ~~pay~~ donate many times more, the fund drive aiming at the total of £1,000,000 One million pounds in 1947.

B. The main purpose of the December 1946 Annual Conference to be "the reorganisation of Congress" to broaden its ambit, oil its machinery ~~and to~~ ~~evolve~~ make it a real mouthpiece and more than that, the liberator of the African People. This Conference will have to evolve strategy for the struggle for National liberation - from the short-term as well as the long-term ~~to~~ view-point. It will have to appoint full-time organisers etc. etc. (In this regard it may be necessary for the December Conference to invite leaders of other African National Organisations to ~~be~~ attend. e.g. Presidents of Ministers' Association, Teachers' Association, Federation of African Trade Unions, ~~etc.~~ Women's Associations, ~~etc.~~ Location Advisory Boards Congress; for, from now on the struggle will have to be collated, and there must not be any African who is untouched by the people's effort under Congress.)

Let us prepare for a five and ten years revolution, which will see first, the going of the N.R.C., to be followed

within a year or so by the going of Native Representation according to the 1936 Act; to be followed by a new rule wherein the African shall be accorded full Democratic Rights. The path thither is a hard one - and may be long or short - depending on the use we make of our resources. It calls for sacrifice, but the Cause is just - and we are ready to make the sacrifices if Congress will lead us courageously ~~and~~ wisely and faithfully; to win justice, wealth welfare and freedom for all in this our Common Country.
