If I lose the case I will have to be compelled to pay out that money. The matter is still going to the Magistrate. Also please receive £1-4-6 money for Constitution 49 copies which makes 100 copies. If you can please send me about 50 more copies or 100 copies. I shall be sending you our financial statement soon. Mr. K. M. was here last week and expressed satisfaction in
