It may interest you to know that I have captured over 100 members ever since I took over. Whereas my predecessor left me with 597 I have gone in two weeks up to 734.

I had a blow as a matter of fact when trying to follow his social functions. I met with police opposition I had to retire at a loss. When I came here he was under arrangement - leased a place outside the Borough I had to complete that work. I met a serious loss indeed, I have to communicate all the particulars to Mr. Johnson.

Last week I banked £7. Today 5-1-10 Subscriptions for only. We are also trying to establish our Club by Voluntary Contributions. I have been cut off from hearing anything about the Rand work. I have written several letters to Comrade H. D. Tyazanka

I have not been able to get any reply  
You remember you faithfully promised to see that  
my property was packed and forwarded to  
me but since I have been here I have heard nothing  
about it. You know Mr. Labadie I do not want to be  
treated like that. I have lived here one of the  
worst lives possible but I do not mind that.  
As I know it is Comrade Madras's doing.

As I reported to you that I had already got a lease  
for 5 years the lease has not yet been signed.  
There seems to be some difficulties in our way now  
some bad people heard of the affair and went  
to the land lord and undermined our name. Any how  
I will see what will happen. Meantime I am not yet  
clear. Keep me informed of your address so that I  
may be able to write you.
