capture Durban despite wonderful
opposition. The Hall that I established has
led me to a Court Case. We shall be
to employ the Solicitors assistance

I have also got another letter
against me by a man who claimed to be
an organizer under Mr. Madonna
I have explained every thing to Mr. Kadatic
You can pull through at this
junction we shall win Dublin.

In future please send me 300 Copies
of the Workers Herald to the Dublin depot
Case for the paper when there is
no paper. I have had no time to attend
at the writing the paper.
