**MR R M SOBUKWE**


Thank you for your letter of 30th April 1984.

In reply to your questions :

- a. It appears that the statement signed by Mr. Dent was merely "to whom it may concern", as it was dated 2nd November 1949, which would have been about the time that Mr. Sobukwe left Fort Hare.
- b. The files do not show if he was a member of the Students Representative Council in 1948.
- c. The subjects which he studied were Xhosa, (major), English (major) Native Administration (major) together with History, Education, Geography and Practical Afrikaans.
- d. His tuition fees for 1947, 1948 and 1949 were £55 per annum of which £20 was paid from the Native Trust Fund, and £20 was a Cape Merit Bursary. The file does not have record of who paid the difference.

There is no further information on his file, apart from what was contained in my previous letter to you. I hope the foregoing is of some help to you.
