Mama Dear.

Yesterday, I received your long letter, and also Vera's letter. I am answering at once, although of course these questions are already too stale, for instance your meeting the children, and why you did not ask someone to meet Vera, all this is now past history.

With regard to arrangements, I also have written you before, and in all probability you have my letter and know by now that I am getting 192. Rubles per month which equals about £20 per month, from which I shall be sending you £10. per month, and will myself live very economical on £10. per month, these are all the arrangements I can make for the present. Of course I know perfectly well how hard it will be for you but of course I thought you might have been able to get part of the house, again it is hard I know to find some one suitable, and to have to do it all your own self and go out to work as well, I can quite understand your position, but still there it is, I am helpless in that respect, later on I may be able to supplement my income by literary work.

Do not send me any stamps yet. for one thing they would be of no use on letters to England, and I am not quite yet at penny-coin or "Kopeiky" level to need it. but I can not wait any day, I think I am writing fairly often as it is.

My garters are going away, perhaps you will send me the warm scarf I left behind, I find I shall want it, it is getting rather cold.

otherwise I do not need any thing as yet.

well I hope you are getting along as best you can and as long as you are all well, I can rest in peace and calm on I we will see what can be done.

About the childrens music, of course if you can afford it all well and good, but I am afraid you will find it hard to manage on the resources at your disposal.

All you have left will soon disappear, and hard
times might require the meagre earnings for something
more important - especially as Vera is not paying
much attention to it.
