## Western Province turn Potchefstroom into a happy hunting ground



EVEN AT unfamiliar Potchefstroom, Western Province were still far too strong for Transvaal, easily beating them by an innings and one run .

Batting first, Western Province were given a solid start of 46 by Abdurahman Jakoet and Noeg Martin. After Martin had been dismissed for 21, Faghme Solomons (28) looked comfortable in helping Jakoet take the total to 97. Solid lower order contributions from Braima Isaacs (38) and Archie Sonn (28) took the visitors to 225 all out.

The Transvaalers were all at sea against the swing bowling of Rushdi Magiet, who took 4/9 in eight impressive overs, and collapsed to 75 all out. Lefty Adams (2/23) and Sonn (2/9) also bowled well.

Asked to follow-on, Transvaal fared only slightly better, reaching 149.

The wickets were shared among Charlie van Schalkwyk (3/7), Sonn (3/12) and Adams (3/39).
