3. It is not lawful to engage a Native who has been longer than six days out of work.
4. Death or desertion must be reported at Pass Office immediately.

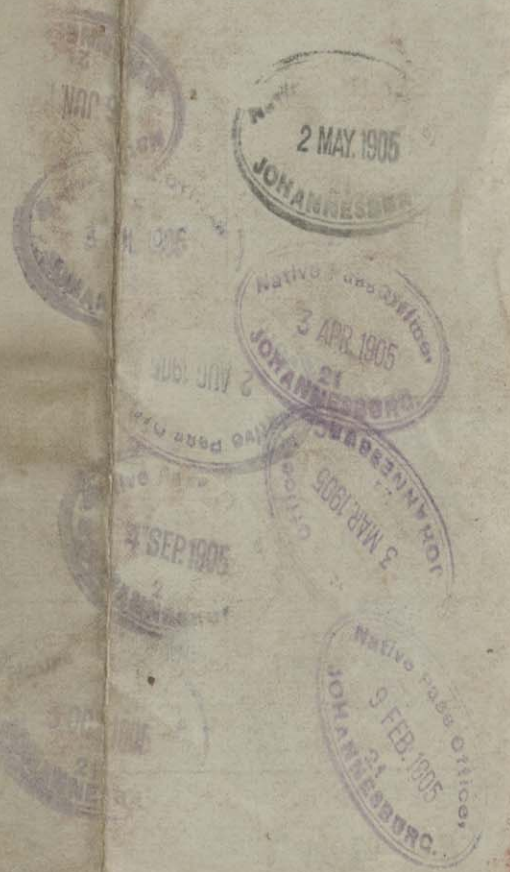
