

Rushdi Magiet's 10-wicket haul sees off the challenge of much improved Transvaal

THE TEAM that failed to top 100 in two attempts at the crease, in their first round match against Western Province in Johannesburg just a few weeks ago, fared much better this time around.

But, they still found the allround strength of the home side too much to handle. Batting first, they compiled 130, with Owen Visser (55) topscoring. WP's "king of swing", Rushdi Magiet, fared best with the ball, taking 5/23. Armiem Jabaar, too, continued his rich vein of form. Another impressive display of legspin bowling earned him 2/25.

Top scorers in the WP reply of 226 were Saait Magiet (62) and new cap, Faghme Solomons (40). Rushdi Magiet picked up five wickets for the second time in the match, as the Transvaalers struggled to 140 all out, with the best contributions coming from Visser (32) and Duncan Stamper (40)

WP made heavy weather of getting 45 for victory, reaching 46 for the loss of five wickets.
