THURSDAY 5TH: ARRIVAL OF HEADS OF STATE AND GOVERNMENT. GABORONE AIRPORT

1100 hrs: All arrangements for the transportation of baggage are completed. Officials responsible for baggage take position at Gaborone Airport.

Officials, members of the press, members of the public, school children arrive at Airport.

1130 hrs: Invited guests, the Mayor of Gaborone, Heads of Diplomatic Missions, Cabinet Ministers, the Speaker of the National Assembly and the Chief Justice and their spouses arrive at Gaborone Airport (See appendices A and B).

The Guard of Honour of the Botswana Defence Force and Band march on.

1140 hrs: Reception line if formed (See Appendix 'A').

1145 hrs: His Excellency the President and Mrs Masire arrive at the Airport and are met by the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of SADCC and the Minister of External Affairs.

1200 hrs: The first Presidential flight arrives. The Heads of State and Government will arrive at intervals of 30 minutes. His Excellency the President and Mrs Masire accompanied by the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of SADCC, the Minister of External Affairs, Acting Executive Secretary of the SADCC, the Commissioner of Police and the Commander, Botswana Defence Force meet the aircraft. The arriving President/Prime Minister descends from the aircraft and is met by His Excellency the President and Mrs Masire.

His Excellency the President will present to the visiting President/-Prime Minister, the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of SADCC, the Minister of External Affairs, the Commissioner of Police, the Commander, Botswana Defence Force.

His Excellency the visiting President/Prime Minister accompanied by His Excellency

President Masire and the Commander, Botswana Defence Force proceed to the dais.

His Excellency the President Dr Q.K.J. Masire presents the visiting President/Prime Minister to the assembled dignitaries at the reception line.

His Excellency the visiting President/Prime Minister accompanied by His Excellency President Masire walk past traditional dancers, school children, and members of the public.

The visiting President/Prime Minister is taken to the Gaborone Sun (See Appendix 'C').

DINNER STATE HOUSE

1900 hrs: Dinner hosted by His Excellency President Dr Q.K.J. Masire in honour of their Excellencies the Presidents/Prime Ministers and the leaders of Ministerial delegations.

FRIDAY 6TH: OPENING OF SUMMIT — NATIONAL STADIUM

0815 hrs: Members of the public are seated.

0830 hrs: Invited guests are seated.

0855 hrs: His Excellency the President and Mrs Masire are received by the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of SADCC and Mrs Mmusi and are shown to their seats.

0900 hrs: The visiting Presidents/Prime Ministers arrive and are met by His Excellency the President and the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of SADCC and the Acting Executive Secretary. The Presidents/Prime Ministers will arrive at intervals of 3 minutes.

0925 hrs: **Opening Ceremony**

1025 hrs: **T E A B R E A K — Gaborone Sun**

1100 hrs: Summit resumes at Gaborone Sun

1230 hrs: Closing Ceremony followed by Press Conference.

1330 hrs: Summit Ends.

LUNCH FOR ALL DELEGATES AND INVITED GUESTS AT GABORONE SUN

DEPARTURE

1330 hrs: Baggage is collected and transported to Gaborone Airport where it is delivered to the Baggage Master for loading. Loading should be completed by 14.45 hrs and flight readied for departure.

1415 hrs: Officials, Members of the public, the Press and school children arrive at the airport and are shown to areas reserved for them.

1430 hrs: Invited guests, the Mayor of Gaborone, Heads of Diplomatic Missions, Cabinet Ministers, the Speaker of the National Assembly and the Chief Justice and their spouses arrive at the Airport and are shown to the areas reserved for them.

1445 hrs: The Guard of Honour of the Botswana Defence Force and Band march on.

1445 hrs: Reception line is formed (See Appendix 'A').

1510 hrs: His Excellency Dr Q.K.J. Masire and the first departing President/-Prime Minister arrive at the airport and are met by the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of SADCC, the Minister of External Affairs and the Acting Executive Secretary.

Their Excellencies start to arrive at intervals of 20 minutes.

Traditional dancers perform.

His Excellency the departing President/Prime Minister accompanied by His Excellency President Masire and Mrs Masire say farewell to the assembled dignitaries at the reception line.

1520 hrs: His Excellency the departing President/Prime Minister takes leave of His Excellency President

Masire and Mrs Masire, the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of SADCC, the Minister of External Affairs and embarks on the Presidential flight.

1530 hrs:

First flight takes off.
